REGIONAL PARK FACILITIES

Kwachon Park, Nose Creek Airdrie, Alberta

In recognition of Airdrie's Korean sister City, the Kwachon Park design was conceived as a unique and picturesque plaza set into Airdrie's Nose Creek Regional Park system. Though relatively small in overall scale, the Kwachon plaza is an integral focal element and central hub for the expansive open space and trail network contained within Nose Creek Park.

In plan view, the clever configuration of planters, varied surfaces and vegetation creates an impressionistic representation of a butterfly – the icon symbolizing the relationship between the two cities. Scott Wright took on the role of lead designer and project coordinator for the parks development, and worked closely with The City of Airdrie during both the design and construction phases of the project.
